Easy Steps to Integration

- Exams are organized into 16 major topic areas with hundreds of subtopics for your convenience.
- Assign exams to correspond with the content covered in your class. For example, fundamentals exams should be assigned to be completed within the first few weeks of class and final exams would be best used for graduating students preparing for the NCLEX.
- Use your curriculum as a guide for assigning exams.
- Exams can be assigned in Practice or Assessment Mode.
- Exams that cover a specific area are recommended to be assigned in Practice Mode, a non-scoring mode for learning with features that build critical thinking.
- Final exams and NCLEX Finals cover many topic areas and are recommended to be assigned in Assessment Mode, a scoring mode option designed to test a student's knowledge. A Review Mode option is available for immediate remediation after an exam is taken in Assessment Mode. These types of exams will be a good gauge of the students' command of the content.
- Remember to lock or unlock your learning mode of choice. The questions in an exam are the same for both Practice and Assessment Modes, so choose ahead of time which mode to make available for students.
- Mandate that students spend one minute per test question in each learning mode.
